Its records state that Elizabeth, wife of Thomas Walton, became a member 3 March 1810 and died in 1815 and that George Walton, father of Thomas, was one of its trustees, a ruling elder, and in 1766 headed the list of subscribers to "a permanent fund for the support of the Gospel." This quaint church, founded about 1744, still stands (see 'Briery Church Manual' by James W. Douglas, Dec., 1828).

(Bk 5, pp. 346-7) The settlement of Thomas Walton's estate by Asa Dupuy, administrator, included payment to Nathaniel Jackson and others for the hire of wagons to return his

slaves from KY, where before his death he had begun farming operations. Records of his estate mention records of his mother's estate and definitely identify him.

"The 1810 Census of Prince Edward County, VA lists in Thomas Walton's family one male under age 10; two age 10-16, and one age 26-45; four females under age 10, one age 16-26 (probably his wife's sister), and one age 26-45; and twenty four slaves. Apparently this census includes Thomas Walton's seven children, his wife, and her sister. In 1817 the children were all minors when they were left without parents or grandparents."

"In Oct 1842, Francis N. Watkins (writer of the Watkins Catalogue), administrator of the estate of Martha Pankey, deceased, sister of Elizabeth Walton, filed a settlement suit in the Superior Court of Prince Edward County, in which he named as children of Thomas and Elizabeth (Pankey) Walton: GEORGE, THOMAS, MARY, the wife of Paul Jones, and "others whose names are unknown." (p 184). The absence of Robert's name from this list suggests that he had died or moved some distance away. Records of Briery Presbyterian Church, which was near the Walton home, state that Robert Walton was received as a member in 1814 and left the church in 1814."

The Eighth Arkansas Regiment

The Eighth Arkansas Regiment was organized near Jacksonport at Camp Price in July 13, 1861. The regiment's first commander was Colonel William K. Patterson. 33rd Regiment, Tennessee Infantry

33rd Infantry Regiment was formed in October, 1861, near Union City, Tennessee. The men were recruited in the counties of Obion, Madison, Lake, Hardeman, and Weakley. Company C contained men from Calloway County, Kentucky. It fought at Shiloh and Perryville, then was stationed at Shelbyville for a few months. The unit served under Generals Stewart, Strahl, and Palmer, and in December, 1862, was consolidated with the 31st Regiment. It partcipated in many battles of the Army of Tennessee from Murfreesboro to Atlanta, moved back to Tennessee with Hood, and was active in North Carolina. This regiment lost 20 killed, 103 wounded, and 17 missing at Shiloh and reported 33 casualties at Perryville. The 31st/33rd lost twenty-three percent of the 379 engaged at Murfreesboro, then the 33rd had 24 disabled at Missionary Ridge and totalled 124 men and 69 arms in December, 1863. It surrendered in April, 1865. The field officers were Colonels Alexander W. Campbell, Warner P. JONES, and Robert N. Payne, and Lieutenant Colonel Henry C. McNeill.

Dr. Thos. Watkins, Dear Cousin,

I take the liberty of sending you some of my school circulars for distribution in your state. They will sufficiently explain themselves. I am anxious to get scholars from Texas and my thoughts turned to you as the kind friend on whom I could rely to send them through that state. Your niece, Miss Kate Hillyer, is now associated with me in my school. The connection was made after the circulars were issued is why her name is not on them. I find her a most efficient teacher and charming associate.

I often see your sister Mrs. Todd. I love her very much. The ties of blood are at all times strong with me but particularly so as I am a stranger in this state. Since you were here, I have had the great misfortune to lose my father. He died after months of suffering with dropsy of the heart. We are now a scattered flock. My little sister, Lizzie, is married and housekeeping. Her mother lives with her. They are nicely fixed and she is quite an enthusiast on the subject of domestic economy.

I am housekeeping. I have a little niece with me and, also my son, who is now seventeen years old. I have a large, comfortable house and a good school. I am making an effort to convert it into a boarding school for young ladies and little girls. Next summer I shall advertise quite extensively in your state as well as throughout the South.

I hope one of these days to see you in Georgia again. We often speak of you and recall your visit with pleasure. Again, apologizing for the trouble I am imposing you, Believe me, Your affectionate cousin, Josephine Ballard
